Studied at the Budapest Music Academy. He was awarded a scholarship abroad and this was soon followed by many concert engagements which took him all over Europe and to North-Central and South-America, as well as to the Far East. In the International Summer School in Castle Weikersheim he directed the soloists' Class for the Violin. During the course of his career he has played with orchestras such as Munich Philharmonic Orchestra, The Bamberg and Vienna Symphony Orchestra, the Stuttgart and Munich Chamber Orchestra and the Masterplayers of Lugano. In addition to the Radio Orchestra Vienna, Zurich, Munich, Stuttgart, Frankfurt, Baden-Baden, Rias, he has also recorded extensively for Deutsche Gramophone, Westminster, Amadeo and Special Record.
